Actor Bio:

Known for his talent, versatility and dedication, Austin Williams is becoming one of the most highly praised and experienced young actors in the business. During many thousands of hours on set, Austin has had the opportunity to work with, and learn from, countless award-winning Directors, Actors and Crew. The word that they most often use to describe Austin is "amazing."

Austin has earned respect and acclaim for the wide range of emotions and characters he has portrayed in both film and television. He can convincingly mold into obnoxiously wealthy, mean, crazy or murderous; And, just as effectively transform into homeless, sweet, grieving, terminally ill or suicidal.

The press has reviewed Austin's performances as "sterling," "heart-wrenching," "brutally sincere," "painfully realistic," "resonant," "authentic," "visceral," "compelling," "impressive," "vulnerable," "deft" and "exceptional." Directors have commended his "raw talent," "drive and focus," "fearlessness" and "true professionalism." People who know him personally will tell you that he is "brilliant" and "a really nice kid."

Since debuting at the age of 8 as a young Matt Damon in Robert De Niro's THE GOOD SHEPHERD, Austin has impressed viewers with leading roles including the precocious son of George Clooney in MICHAEL CLAYTON, a bully to Elle Fanning in PHOEBE IN WONDERLAND, the disturbed son of Adrian Pasdar in HOME MOVIE, and a memorable performance in BURNING PALMS.

Austin has also made an lasting impression on TV, Guest Starring as an abused child in CBS's A GIFTED MAN, a murder accomplice on LAW & ORDER, a student on RESCUE ME, and as bully and cancer victim Shane Morasco in almost 300 episodes of the daytime drama ONE LIFE TO LIVE. Notably, Austin is the youngest male actor ever to be offered a contract with a soap opera, at age 10.

In 2012, Austin will star in the animated film HENRY & ME (also starring Richard Gere and many of the past and present Yankees) and the feature film SUGAR, in which he portrays a homeless teen struggling to survive on the streets of Los Angeles.

When not on set, Austin lives with his parents, grandparents, sister and dog. He is a MENSA member with a genius IQ whose future plans include the study of film. A Director recently wrote to Austin urging him "keep doing this - you were meant to touch peoples lives." Austin hopes to do just that, both in front of and behind the camera.
